The higher geographies contained in this concordance are: territorial authority (TA) and regional council (REGC).</P><P STYLE="font-size:16ptmargin:7 0 7 0;">Statistical area 2 (SA2) is a new output geography that provides higher aggregations of population data than can be provided at the statistical area 1 (SA1) level. The SA2 geography aims to reflect communities that interact together socially and economically.
